1 We were made for life with God

2 Sin brought separation and death

We have all sinned and turned from God. Sin separates us from the One who gives life and brings just judgement. Good deeds and religion cannot rescue us.

3 Jesus came to rescue us

God did not abandon us. Jesus Christ, the sinless Son of God, died on the cross in our place and rose bodily from the grave. He opened the way back to God.

4 You can receive new life

Salvation is God's gift. Turn from sin and trust Jesus as your Saviour and Lord. In Him there is forgiveness, peace with God, and eternal life.
